## REQUEST UNDER THE FREEDOM OF INFORMATION (SCOTLAND) ACT 2002 (FOISA)

Thank you for your request dated 26<sup>th</sup> February 2024 under the Freedom of Information (Scotland) Act 2002 (FOISA). You asked for information on:

- Q1. Details of the salary and rewards package paid to the Chief Executive and Directors of your organisation?
- Q2. Details of the amount paid to each in expenses over each of the last 5 years please what these were paid for.
- Q3. Details of the amount collectively paid in by your organisation to the pension pots of these senior officers in each of the last five years.

Please note, I am not asking for the names of individuals but would appreciate all data provided by designation.

## Our Response:

Consumer Scotland was set up in April 2022. The remuneration details for our senior management team and board members can be found in our published 2022-23 Annual Report and Accounts (<a href="https://consumer.scot/publications/annual-report-and-accounts-2022-2023">https://consumer.scot/publications/annual-report-and-accounts-2022-2023</a>). This includes pay/fees and pension accruals.

Expenses for 2022-23 were as follows:

- Board members £1,788 relates to travel to Board meetings
- Senior Management Team £61 relates to reimbursement of travel expenses
